

APPLICANT INFORMATION

To enter our program:

During your orientation interview you were given instructions to call David Kroessig at 530-343-1935, **between 8:15am and 8:30am**, Monday through Friday. Please do not call until you are ready to enter our program. If you reach an answering machine, leave **1** short message including your name and phone number. If we're ready for you to come into the program we will notify you.

IMPORTANT: Any prescribed medications must be approved in advance and you must bring at least a 30 day supply, with refills. Except for medical emergencies, there will be no appointments during the blackout period.

When you enter the program there will be a 60 day "blackout" period. No phone use and you are not allowed to leave the premises without prior approval. You are allowed to send and receive mail and you can have visitors beginning the third weekend. Excluding ministry events, generally visiting hours are:

Saturday—12pm to 4:30pm

Sunday—upon return from church—4pm
